Opened in May 1962, the Old Course at St Pierre held its first major golf tournaments, the Welsh Open and the Dunlop Masters in 1971. The Dunlop Masters, which later became the Silk Cut Masters, was held no less than 8 times. From 1986 to 1996, St Pierre played host to the Epton Grand Prix Match Play and Stroke Play tournaments and the prestigious Solheim Cup with the USA being victorious.

Past winners include Seve Ballesteros, Greg Norman, Tony Jacklin, Bernhard Langer, Ian Wooshan and Jose Maria Olazabal all of whom became successful Ryder Cup Captains.

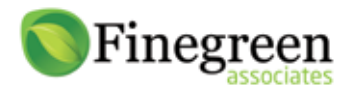
