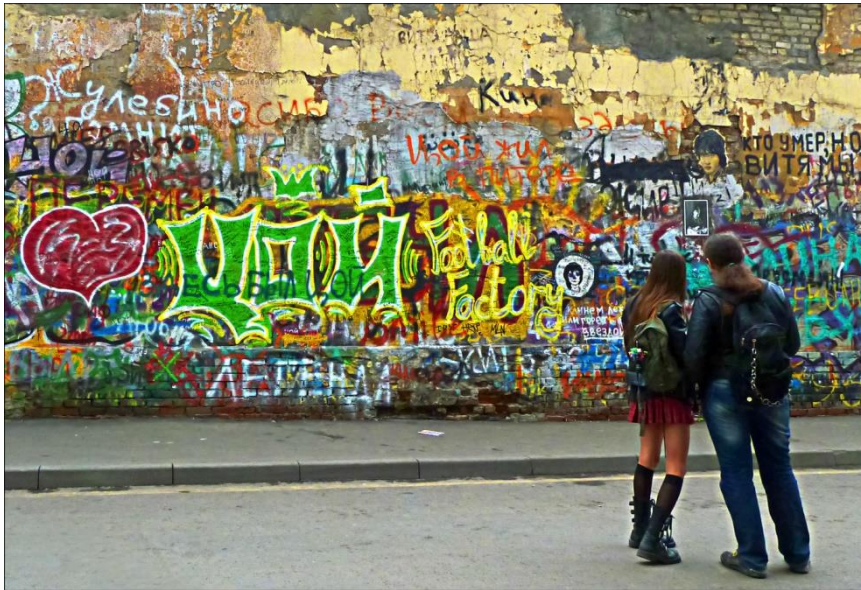


### **'IN THE CITY' COMPETITION**
