



The M25 Group consists of around 30 branches who are based within the M25 or just outside plus a number of other branches within the South East England area who have expressed a wish to be members. The purpose of the Group is to share events and information about speakers where appropriate. Member branches are offered the opportunity to contact Sally Bundock, the Development Officer for South East England, to extend an invitation to one or more of their branch meetings or outings. Details are then circulated to all Branch Secretaries who are able to extend the invitation to their own branch members.

The Group is of particular interest to new or smaller branches. It is appreciated that some larger branches are often tight for space at branch meetings and so will not wish to invite others to their branch meetings. They can, however, offer events from other branches to their own branch members who may perhaps like to take part in more Fellowship events than their own branch offers. They may also have some useful information to circulate about speakers (no circulation would be made without the individual's permission of course).

The M25 Group has been running since the summer of 2018. Since then around 40 Bulletins have been issued.
